**COLT LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING AT AGAWAM REVOLVER CLUB,  
SOUTHWICK, MA.**

On behalf of COLT DEFENSE LLC, please allow this to announce the November 2008 training schedule at the Agawam Revolver Club outdoor range located in Southwick, Ma.

My name is Jim Markowski and I am the Director of Law Enforcement Sales & Training at Colt Defense. I am a retired Special Agent with the Bureau of ATF. I retired as the Division Tactical Advisor for the Boston Field Division. I was a member of ATF's Special Response Team Program for fifteen years. I retired from ATF after a thirty-three year productive career.

Colt Defense is currently providing assorted tactical and live fire training for the law enforcement, military and private security community. All Colt instructors are experienced real world tactical operators from a law enforcement/special operations background. Safety is the #1 priority mandated at all training evolutions.

On **Tuesday November 18, 2008** Colt Law Enforcement Training will put on a one day tactical pistol course and on **Wednesday November 19, 2008**, a one day tactical rifle course. The cost for each course is \$150.00. The theme of both training courses will be the first person to put effective rounds on target, wins the gunfight.

**Tactical Pistol**

Shooters will be required to bring his/her duty pistol with at least three magazines, retention/belt holster, double magazine pouch, eye and ear protection, and 500 rounds of pistol ammunition.

**Tactical Rifle**

Shooters will be required to bring his/her duty rifle, equipped with a sling, three rifle magazines, double rifle magazine pouch, duty pistol with at least one magazine, retention/belt holder, eye and ear protection, 500-750 rounds of rifle ammunition, 100 rounds of handgun ammunition.

Both courses will discuss/demonstrate the Survival Triangle consisting of Marksmanship – ability to hit your target, Manipulation – ability to handle your weapon, Mindset – 100% concentration, 100% of the time.

Both courses will discuss/demonstrate proper grip, drawing and holstering, loading & unloading, press checks, positions of carry, immediate action and remedial action drills, combat reload, tactical reload, magazine exchange, presentation, scan, shooter's box concept, and Shooting on the Move addressing both single and multiple threats. The tactical rifle course will also include transition to the handgun drills.

Both courses will immediately commence at 0830 hours with the range safety briefing.
