



COLT DEFENSE LLC together with SIMUNITIONS OPERATIONS will be offering a law enforcement tactical course titled **HIGH RISK ENTRIES/ROOM CLEARING/TACTICAL MOVEMENT**. The course will include tactical room clearing techniques utilizing Simunitions (force on force training with role players.) This course will enhance law enforcement's ability to react to any tactical situation in a consistent and effective manner.

This course will evolve from a basic two-person room entry and progress to multiple team members making entries and clearing an entire structure. The course will also include *UC officer rescue from both known and unknown locations within a structure*. The course will further include *response to an Active Shooter scenario when the shooting has stopped and law enforcement has no intelligence on the whereabouts of the shooter(s)*. *This segment of the course will offer techniques utilizing the minimum of a three-person element to clear the structure in an attempt to locate the shooter(s)*.

This training will occur at the **SIMUNITIONS INDOOR TRAINING FACILITY LOCATED AT 65 SANDSCREEN ROAD, AVON, CT. 06001-0576**. The course will run from **Wednesday June 23, 2010 and end on Thursday June 24, 2010**. The cost of the course for each student is **\$300.00**.

Students will be required to bring his/her agency duty **SIMUNITIONS PISTOL/KIT** for the training, as there are not sufficient Simunitation handguns/kits available for the students. Students will also need to bring a magazine pouch for both primary and secondary weapons, if applicable.

All respective Simunitions safety/training equipment, Simunitions ammunition, will be provided. It is recommended that students/LEO's, bring all the daily gear that is utilized on a daily basis. We highly recommend the warrior concept of **TRAIN AS YOU FIGHT**.

There will be a maximum number of **fifteen (15)** students for the course. All students will have the opportunity to serve as a suspect in a role player status. One of the beliefs of this training course is that LEO's become better operators after serving as a suspect/role player as threat angles will be viewed differently.
