

# Tactical Rifle Course

The training theme of Colt is “The first person to put effective rounds on target wins the gunfight.” This training will primarily consist of practical applications on the firearms range. Topics covered will include: Survival / Combat Triangle, Marksmanship, Weapon Manipulation, Positions of Carry (point, ready, retention, kneeling, prone), Loading and Unloading and Transitioning to Handgun, Offset-Offset-Offset-15 yards and in, SOP's after engaging a threat, Emergency Reload / Combat Reload, Tactical Reload, Magazine Exchange, Immediate Action – transition to handgun, Double Feed, Shooting on the move (combat glide, moving forward, moving backward, moving laterally, Range Drills (initial range qualification course, presentation drills, retention position drills, low wall barricade, high wall barricade – Deliberate / Dynamic, 50 yard drills, Shoot on the Move, Room entry drills, 90 degree turns, 180 degree turns, obstacle course, group drills, and Final qualification course.
